



## Applied Microbial Remediation Technician

This 4 day, hands-on Applied Microbial Remediation Technician course covers mold and sewage remediation techniques to individuals engaged in property management, property restoration, IEQ investigations or other related professions. Emphasis will be placed on teaching mold and sewage remediation techniques to individuals who will perform these procedures in the field. Course graduates will be adequately equipped to perform remediation services, while protecting the health and safety of workers and occupants.

Hands on training will be at least 25% of the course.

All students will participate in the following:

- Erecting containment, including mini-containment and demonstrating the principle of decontamination chambers
- Temporary containment, such as zip walls, critical barriers, Z-flap; to install floor sheet(s), erect wall sheet(s), ceiling sheet, using necessary materials and supplies
- Establishing and monitoring negative pressure and managing airflow in each of the containment areas
- Demolition of drywall with simulated microbial contamination (dust control methods)
- HEPA vacuuming and cleaning procedures
- Removal of simulated mold from wood studs
- Donning and doffing of person protection equipment
- Containment (bagging) of contaminated materials

This course is designed to be a hands-on, in depth learning experience that provides professional restorers with the necessary tools to perform mold and sewage remediation. Mold contamination has been identified as a major contributor to building related illness and poor indoor air quality.

**PLEASE NOTE:** \*Water Damage Restoration Technician is a mandatory pre-requisite course needed in order to attend the AMRT and/or ASD. Those taking the AMRT and/or ASD course must have already attended AN IICRC Certified Water Damage Restoration Technician course. Those attendees whom have neglected to obtain this pre-requisite will NOT be eligible to write the exam nor will they be able to gain credit for the course. **Please note there is a \$150 Exam fee payable at the time of exam to the IICRC with credit card or cheque in US funds.**
